CONTENT MARKETING STATISTICS



The success of your content marketing strategy depends on the nature of your content. If your content is good and by good I mean straight out of the top drawer, it will bolster your content marketing efforts. On the other hand, if it is fairly ordinary, your inbound marketing campaign will fall apart faster than you realize.

If you are a part of the 77% B2C or 86% B2B organizations using content marketing to boost brand growth, you must make a concerted attempt to come up with high quality content that not only disseminates useful information but also does so in a manner that is engaging and arresting.

To convert leads: In-person events, case studies and webinars/online events.

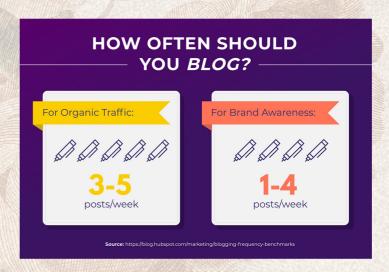

Blogging Statistics

According to Hubspot, the publishing frequency depends on your goal and team size.

For organic traffic: small blogs should post new 3-4 pieces weekly and large blogs should aim for 4-5 pieces every week including new and updated posts.

For brand awareness: small blogs should publish 1-2 new posts. As for large publications, they should post 3-4 times weekly including both updated and new posts.

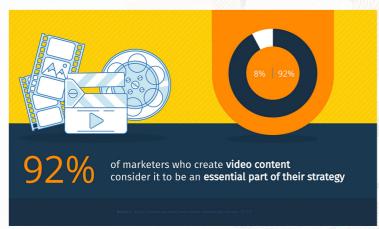




Video Content Marketing Statistics

Video is another content format that's been doing pretty well. Statistically speaking, viewers consume 6 hours and 48 minutes of online videos each week.

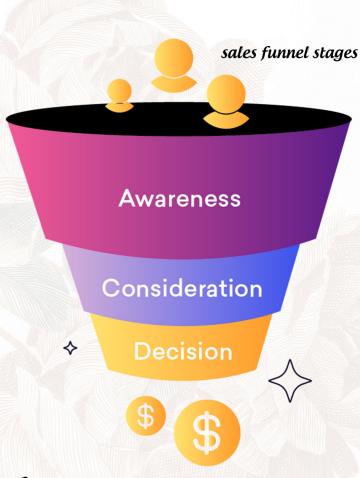




How content marketing works

Your business can use content marketing to attract leads, make a case for your product or service when someone is researching what to buy, and close sales.

To use it effectively, you'll need to deliver the right content at each stage of the sales cycle—from awareness through consideration to purchase.



Awareness stage

Content at the awareness stage should be educational, how-to advice.

The best content for this stage includes articles, blog posts, e-books, videos, and newsletters.

Examples:

A restaurant writes a blog post about how to plan a menu for a graduation party in the spring.

A bike touring company creates a short video on the topic "3 Ways to Choose the Right Bike Trip."

An architecture firm creates an e-book called "Questions to Ask Before Hiring an Architect."



Consideration stage

In the consideration stage, content should offer a hybrid of helpful information and marketing.

Once your ideal customers reach this funnel, they're no longer looking for surface-level, introductory content.

You'll instead want to look towards creating content that nurtures prospective customers further down the funnel. They might be looking for customer stories, product reviews, or a how-to video/articles or worksheets.

Looking at the results from a Semrush study, the following types of content work best when attracting traffic.

"How-to" guide (44%). Product overview (40%). Case study (34%). Landing page (31%). Webinar (31%). Success story (30%)

Consider these potential customers were likely already introduced to your brand during the discovery stage, and therefore should not be presented with discovery stage content.

An effective content strategy entails personalizing content for your audience.

The content you present during the consideration phase can make the difference between a conversion and a lost sale. The top-performing content types in this stage include:

Product overview. Customer review. Success story.

Consider sharing success stories of current customers that are similar to your prospect at this stage of the funnel.

Conclusion

Having a comprehensive and cohesive content strategy is critical for creating a rewarding buying experience. Keep your audience in mind with each piece of content you create.

You'll also want to have a thorough understanding of your target customer, how they think, what they are looking for, and how you can solve their problem.

An effective content marketing funnel takes time, testing, and patience to perfect, but it's absolutely necessary to outshine your competitors and come out on top.

Closing stage

Content marketing plays an important role when a prospect is close to buying. At this stage, you can focus on sales, as long as you continue to drive home why you're the best choice rather than just how great your services or products are.





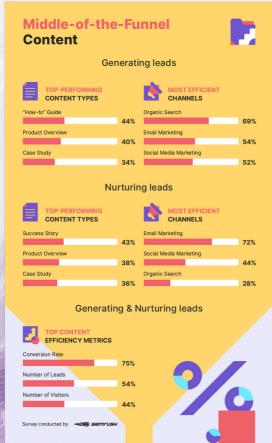

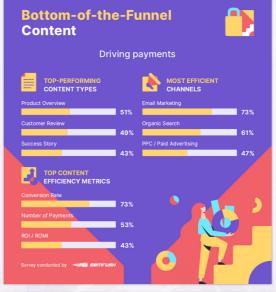


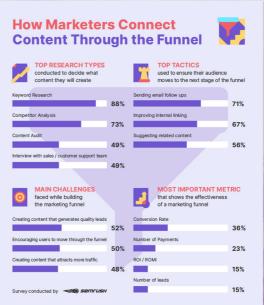
Anatomy of a Powerful Content Marketing Funnel [SEMrush Survey Stats]













1. Audit Your Current Social Media Platforms

Before you begin to plan or schedule any of your content for next month, do an inventory of the platforms you are using.

Many companies think they need to make accounts on every social platform, giving them all equal attention. If that sounds like your company, take stock of performance on each platform over the last year. For example, if you've been posting tweets on the company's Twitter account consistently but have seen no indication of growth, engagement, or sales from Twitter, it may be time to phase that out and redirect that energy and attention to a platform that is actually working for you. It's okay not to be everywhere all at once, all of the time.

Prioritizing the best platforms for your business can help you free up the time and energy to make content that will actually convert.

When it comes to social media marketing, you must have a concrete strategy (as opposed to posting anything, everywhere, just to see what works). So how else can you be intentional about the platforms you utilize most? Go where your customers are.

If you know generally the demographics your customers fall into, you can find out which social platforms they are spending the most time on, and you can meet them where they are.

2. Prioritize Video Content

Now that you've done your research and have taken stock of which platforms are working best for your business, you can begin to plan your content for 2023.

At the forefront of your content planning should be video content, short-form, or long-form. Every social media platform has video capability, and with TikTok speedily rising in the ranks to become the most popular app, all other social media platforms are trying to follow suit.



On Instagram and Facebook, Reels are being pushed to users above all other types of content, and in 2023 we can expect to see this continue. This year, brands overall earned nearly 40% more engagement using Reels on Instagram than they did with other types of posts.

3. Use Social Media Personally

Many businesses are missing the mark when it comes to successful social media, and the key reason is that they are approaching it like traditional marketing and not from the viewpoint of the user.

You would never sell a product that you yourself haven't used and can attest to its value; why would you create content if you're not a content consumer as well?

In using social media apps, you will not only keep up with trends that your company could follow, but you will also be able to gain priceless insights from your customer base by seeing how they interact with competitors or even other businesses in different industries.

The best way to "win" at social media marketing is to embrace it as an average daily user would.

4. Define Your Metrics For Success

Now that you're ready to strategize how to make your social media marketing stand out in 2023, how will you do so? It's pivotal that you define what success looks like for you.

Start by recognizing any roadblocks within your company/brand as a whole and ask, "How can social media help us navigate this

For example, perhaps a roadblock you frequently hit is customer confusion, and you are always educating customers on your product or service.

How can social media marketing help?

Maybe by creating short- and long-form video content on social media that addresses common questions and educates people on the product or service.

So how would we measure the success of that effort?

Probably through metrics *like the number of* videos posted, the amount of engagement those posts receive, and a decrease in the number of questions coming your way.

Assign some specific numbers to those metrics to create your goals, and now you've got somewhere to go.



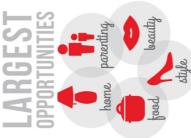

What is Affiliate Marketing?

Affiliate marketing is a way for you (the affiliate) to earn a commission for recommending products or services to your friends or readers.

To simplify it, here's the 5 step process for how to start affiliate marketing:

You find a product you want to promote Do a search for "product name" affiliate program. If it's on Amazon, you can also promote it

Sign up for their affiliate program

You get a special link that allows the merchant to track the people who clicked your link.

If they buy the product, you get a commission.

How Does Affiliate Marketing Work?

There are a lot of different ways to track affiliates these days, but nearly all of them are based on someone clicking your special tracking link.

The most common and basic type of tracking is via a cookie.

When an affiliate link is clicked, a small file called a cookie is stored on the user's computer. Then they buy a promote an product, the merchant can see that you should. they were referred by you.



Affiliate Marketing

How Much Money Can You Make With Affiliate Marketing?

The amount you can make falls somewhere between zero and millions.

Your income will be directly related to the type of offers you promote, how much traffic you get to the site, and your grasp of other online marketing skills like email marketing and SEO.

How Do You Become an Affiliate Marketer?

You can pick just about any product that you can buy online, and there will be an affiliate program that will pay you a finders fee for referring a sale.

However, just because you can promote anything, doesn't mean you should.

The most important thing to consider when selecting a product to market is, "is it relevant to your audience?"



Types of Affiliate Products: Physical vs. Information vs. Services

There are three different types of affiliate products you can promote as a marketer

Physical Products Information Products Services

Physical products are probably the easiest thing to promote for one reason, and one reason only: Amazon.

Amazon has the world's largest affiliate program, and once you sign up, you can get a link for any product on the site, earn a (small) commission on it!

As it sits currently, you can earn between 1 and 4.5% on any product you promote through the Amazon affiliate program. What that percentage is depends on the category it falls into.

One of the nice things about promoting via Amazon is that you get a commission on everything the buyer purchases - not just the specific product link they clicked on.

Example:

So let's say that I'm promoting some golf balls on my golf website.

The balls cost \$50, so I'll only earn \$1.50. But, what if that same person also buys a set of golf clubs for \$1,000, and a new golf rangefinder for \$300?

Then all of a sudden that \$1.50 turns into \$41.50.

Amazon has a 24 hour cookie. So what that means is that if someone clicks on your link, they then have 24 hours to make a purchase in order for you to get credit.

It also doesn't have to be for the product they clicked on. If they click on your golf ball link and then buy a new TV? You still get credit!

Other Affiliate Networks to Consider

Most larger companies will use what's called an affiliate network to host their products.

These are sites you sign up for that might represent dozens of brands, and it's how you get your special links and marketing materials.

But the major affiliate networks are:

Affiliate Marketing for Information Products

What is an information product?

It's a digital product, course, or community that is created by an expert in their field.







How To Do Affiliate Marketing - Step by Step

STEP 1: Create an online presence and niche.

Before promoting products, you must have a platform and create online content, such as social media posts and/or a blog. Selecting a niche allows you to focus on one specific market and better target your audience.





STEP 2: Research how you stand out from your competitors.

This process will help you figure out what your competitors are doing and how you can stand out. It can also help you determine which products to promote and which niche to work with.

STEP 3: Find the best platform.

Platforms such as websites and YouTube channels are ideal for growing an audience and promoting your brand. However, if you're looking to grow your business, you should consider using a variety of platforms.





STEP 4: Discover which affiliate network gives you the most returns.

Assess these factors before choosing an affiliate network: cookie duration, competition, the network and the merchant's reputation, brand alignment, fees, and the level of support.

STEP 5: Decide on what to promote.

The products you choose must align with your brand and values. Promoting a product you're already using and one you would highly recommend to others is best if you're just starting.





STEP 6: Optimize your site's content.

When you create valuable and informative content, you help your audience and position yourself as an authority in your field. Highquality content can help you rank higher on search engine results pages (SERPs). The more traffic you get, the more chances you have of making a sale.

Reasons that information products are so great to promote:

Often they are higher priced, which means higher commissions

They can have a personality behind them, which builds trust and makes them easier to sell

There are often full marketing funnels behind them aiding in sales

They solve a problem or provide a solution that your readers are looking for.

Generally, it can be a little bit more work to become an affiliate for these products because often the creator is a bit more protective of who they let market the products.

There's also no central place you can go to join like you could with Amazon. Usually, you'll need to talk to the author directly or look for an "affiliates" page on their product site.

Affiliate Marketing for Service Products

The third type of product you can promote is a service.

Think about which services you use and if it makes sense to promote them on your site.

You can usually expect commissions between 15-30% on service products - sometimes higher or lower depending on what it is. Or if it's a single payment, you can expect it to be equivalent to 2 months of payments.

If you have a website related to online marketing, blogging, or business, there are fortunately a lot of really solid affiliate programs out there for different services.

How to Promote an Affiliate Offer

By now you should have a good sense of what affiliate marketing is, have an idea of what products you want to promote and know how to get your affiliate links for them.

But if you don't know how to properly promote them, it doesn't really matter now, does it? Nope.

The easiest thing you can do right now to bring in a few sales over the coming weeks: create a resource page.

Regardless of what your business is, there are tools, products, and services that you use to run your blog or business.

By putting together a page of all of your tools and resources, you're creating something that's shareable, as well as useful.

Google Ads Vs **Facebook Ads: How Do They Work?**

Both Facebook Ads and Google Ads are pay-per-click (PPC) advertising platforms, but there are differences in how they work.

Facebook Ads are known as paid social (ads are displayed in users' social media feeds). Google Ads, on the other hand, are paid search ads that are displayed in Google's search results.



It's audience targeting. Since Facebook users aren't actively looking for a product or service, the platform gives advertisers comprehensive targeting options such as factors like age, gender, income, and interests.

You can easily create ads in Facebook Ads Manager by following the steps given below:

Click the "Create" button on your account dashboard.

Choose your ad format. Select your audience Edit ad settings Create an ad copy and images.

However, you should be aware that it takes more time to convert Facebook leads to customers as they are not actively seeking your product or service.



Google processes more than 40,000 search queries every second, more than 3 billion per day and a little over a trillion every year so imagine the reach of your business when you promote it using Google Ads.

Google Ads

To create ads on Google, you have to

Sign up for a Google Ads account, and then add text-only ad copies and keyword targeting information.

Ads are built in the Google Ad Manager interface, which is a bit complicated for inexperienced people.

Audience intent is the USP of Google Ads.

On Google, users are actively searching for a specific product or service, or the answer to a specific question. If you can provide them with what they're looking for, it increases the chances of conversion. Unlike Facebook Ads, Google Ads are largely triggered by keywords and search terms.

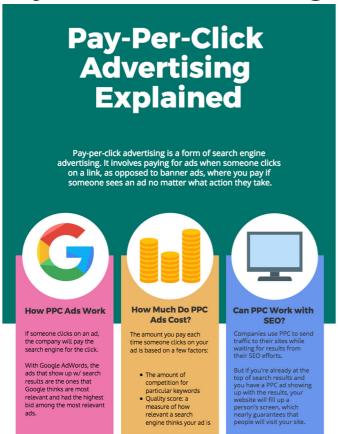


When to Use?

Use Facebook Ads to build brand awareness of products or services that people want but do not need, such as a new high-tech espresso machine, as part of the brand marketing. Google Ads can be used to increase the sales of products or services that people need and actively search for, such as a plumber or carpenter.

If you own a business you should be advertising on Google.

Pay Per Click Advertising



How Does Pay-Per-Click Advertising Work?

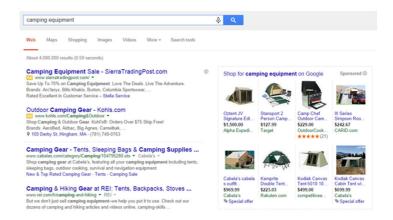
In order for ads to appear alongside the results on a search engine (commonly referred to as a Search Engine Results Page, or SERP), advertisers cannot simply pay more to ensure that their ads appear more prominently than their competitor's ads.

Instead, ads are subject to what is known as the Ad Auction, an entirely automated process that Google and other major search engines use to determine the relevance and validity of advertisements that appear on their SERPs.

How Keywords Work in Pay-Per-Click Advertising

As its name implies, the Ad Auction is a bidding system. This means that advertisers must bid on the terms they want to "trigger," or display, their ads. These terms are known as keywords.

Say, for example, that your business specializes in camping equipment. A user wanting to purchase a new tent, sleeping bag, or portable stove might enter the keyword <u>"camping equipment"</u> into a search engine to find retailers offering these items.



At the moment the user submits their search query, the search engine performs the complex algorithmic calculations that the Ad Auction is based upon. This determines which ads are displayed, in which order, and by which advertiser.

Since you have to pay for each click on your ads, it's imperative to only bid on keywords that are relevant to your business, so you can be sure to get ROI from your ad spend.

A keyword tool can help you find the right keywords to bid on that are both likely to drive sales or conversions, and are not prohibitively expensive.

How to Optimize Your Pay-Per-Click Ads

Pay-per-click marketing can be a very cost-effective way to drive traffic to your website and grow your business. But it takes time and effort to do it right.

A number of factors can affect your PPC costs, including:

The relevance of the keywords you choose to bid on - Are they the search terms your best audience is really using to find products they want to buy, or solutions to their problems?

The quality of your ads and landing pages - Google awards the best ad placements and the lowest costs to businesses that provide a good consumer experience. Your click-through rate, or CTR, is a good indication of whether or not your ad creative is resonating with people.

A solid account structure - Your PPC account is like a house. Everything needs to be built on a strong foundation.

Facebook Advertising Costs

With an average CPC of \$1.72, Facebook Ads have a required minimum daily ad spend equal to two clicks per day. For example, if a business has a CPC of \$1, based on factors like audience targeting and time of day an ad runs, then its minimum daily ad spend is \$2. Facebook Ads are an affordable PPC platform, with average CPCs below Google Ads.

The targeting options offered by Facebook include demographic information, interests, browsing behaviour, location, political affiliations, life events, and dozens of other parameters.

Average Conversion Rate

The conversion rate of an ad indicates how often it successfully achieved the action you wanted users to take.

It could be signing up for a newsletter or completing a purchase.

The average conversion rate on Facebook ads is a high 9.21%, which means that for every 100 clicks on an ad, just over nine users click on an ad and complete the desired action on the connected landing page.

Ad Types

Facebook currently offers six different options for ad types or ad formats. These include the image, video, slideshow, carousel, collection, and instant experience (formerly canvas) ads.

These ads give advertisers the opportunity to use their creativity and encourage audience engagement. But this is not possible in Google Ads as they are text-based ads.

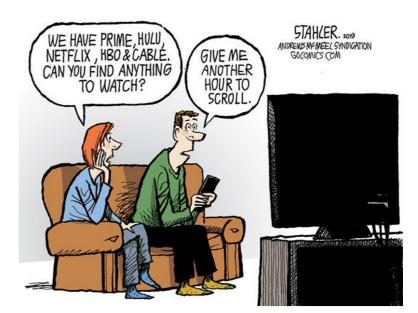

Using DALL·E to create AI artwork is remarkably simple.

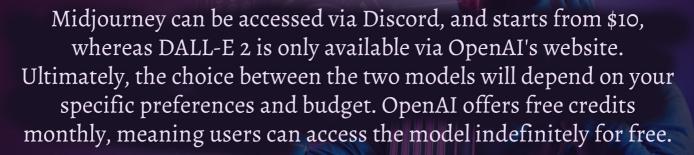
There are three main ways to create an image: text prompts, variations, and edits.

What is cybersecurity, and why is it important?

Top Cybersecurity Tips for everyday users

1. Keep software up-to-date

Software companies provide software updates to add new features, fix known bugs, and upgrade security.

Always update to the latest version of your software to protect yourself from security vulnerabilities.

2. Back up your data

Backing up the data on your devices by copying it to another, separate

location — is one of the most important things you can do. If you're targeted by a cyber attack you may not be able to access or use your computer, phone, or any of your other devices. But, if you've backed your data up you won't lose any of it, regardless of what ends up happening to your device.

Get an external hard drive and do an 'offline' or 'cold' backup, or sign up to a cloud based service like Dropbox and do a cloud backup. Back up your data regularly — for example, every week.

3. Choose unique passwords

We all have so many online accounts now that it's become hard to keep track of all of the passwords we need for them.

To combat this, many of us use the same password for all of our accounts, or stick to two or three different ones that we use over and over.

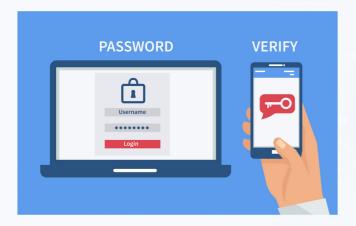
The problem with this is that if an attacker gets access to one of your account passwords, it often gives them access to many of your other accounts as well.



4. Use Two-Factor or Multi-Factor Authentication

Two-factor adds additional layers of security to the standard password method of online identification.

With two-factor, you would be prompted to enter one additional authentication method such as a PIN Code, or even fingerprint.



5. Avoid sensitive transactions on free wifi

It's good to be careful about what you do online when you're using a hotspot or free wifi — if you're logging on at a cafe, for example — as these networks are often unsecure & anyone can access it and get hold of your data. So while it's ok to check the news or the weather, try to keep more sensitive transaction use to a minimum.

Avoid doing online shopping or internet banking on free wifi or an unsecure network.

If you need to check your email, make sure you have two-factor authentication set up first.

Use your own device where possible, not someone else's.

6. Be careful what you click

Avoid visiting unknown websites or downloading software from untrusted sources. These sites often host malware that will automatically install (often silently) and compromise your computer.

If attachments or links in the email are unexpected or suspicious for any reason, don't click on it.

7. Be smart about social media

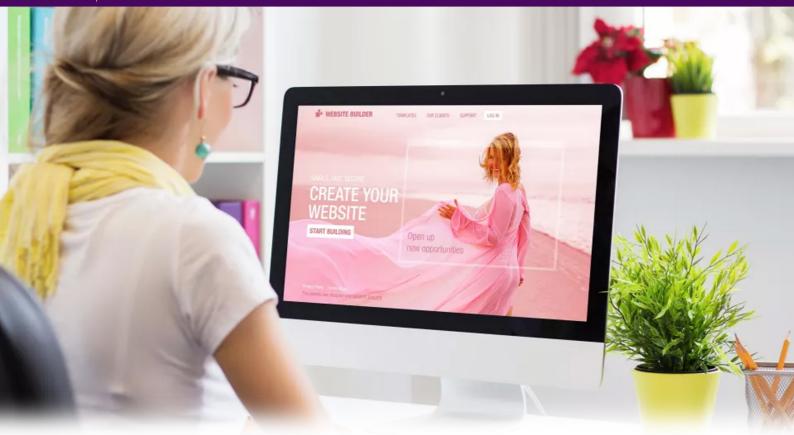
Did you know that the information you post to your Facebook, Twitter or IG could be used to steal your identity or hack into your online accounts?
